

I) Michael Beach: Band Leader, Lead Vocals, Doumbek (Middle Eastern Drums), Mizmar & Midjwiz (reeded instruments)

I. One Lead Vocal mic on boom stand.

2. Two Doumbek (hand drums) mics on boom stands.

3. For large concert / festival stages - One ambient mic on short boom for kick pedal tambourine

4. Two quality monitors (ideally 15 inch) on separate mix. Needs to hear his vocals, his drums, kick drum, high hat, keyboards and string instruments very clean and HOT in his monitors.

5. Please use huge reverb (like in an exotic pyramid or a temple) on his vocal mic when he is singing; especially when he is singing that crazy Middle Eastern vocal improvisation stuff and when he is playing the reeded instruments.

Please turn it off in between songs when he is talking though. Use SOME reverb on his lead drum.

6. PLEASE NOTE: MB's doumbeks are not just a percussion instrument. They are the main sound of the band; especially the lead high Arabic Tabla/ Doumbek. These hand drums need to be VERY hot in his monitors and in the front of the mix of the whole band in the main speakers.

- 3. One Monitor for his vocals


3) Clark Salisbury: Saz, Oud (acoustic/traditional stringed instruments), Electric Guitar & Vocals

I Vocal mic (boom stand) DI (PA/mixer/amp) AC Mic on guitar amp I Monitor (predominantly Saz and Oud, and vocals)

4) Drumkit (5-piece)

Drum mics: Bass drum and hit hat. Lead percussionist must hear bass and hi hat in his monitors. Rest of kit to be miked according to room capacity.

Sound Equipment Needed:

- I. Three vocal mics
- 2. Four to nine drum mics
- (mix engineer's choice)
- 3. Two DIs
- 4. At least two AC outlet strips
- 5. Four to five monitors
